

THE 200 CLUB

This is the name for the group of individuals who give regularly to The Youth Net (MSYN)

WHY THE 200 CLUB?

We believe that the best way to find our work is through having individuals giving regularly. As well as giving us an income to match our expenditure it also means that there is a group of individuals committed to our work, not just financially, but prayerfully and practically too.

We have named this group the 200 Club as our aim is to have a 200 people giving £10/month.

HOW TO GIVE

Most 200 Club members give via monthly standing order. However if this is not practical, gifts by other methods (eg. CAF) are equally acceptable.

GIFT AID

Gift Aiding your gifts will increase them by 25%. See further details below.

HOW DOES IT WORK?

The Gift Aid Scheme allows taxpayers to give to the church in such a way that the tax you have already paid can be claimed back and added to your giving. A gift of £10 increases in value to £12.50 and a gift of £100 will increase in value to £125. All you have to do is sign the 'Gift Aid Declaration'.

WHO CAN GIVE?

You need to be a taxpayer and pay enough income tax (at whatever rate) or capital gains tax in each tax year to cover the tax reclaimed on your giving.

WHAT ARE MY OBLIGATIONS?

None. There is no legal commitment to continue. If for any reason you need to stop, you can.

AND IF I PAY HIGHER TAX RATE?

There's good news for you! Higher rate taxpayers receive extra tax relief claimed through their tax return.

OTHER WAYS OF TAX-EFFECTIVE GIVING

Some people find it easier to use an agency that specialises in tax-effective giving. The following are some of the better known:

- Charities Aid Foundation (CAF)
- Stewardship Services (UKET)
- Impact Giving

Some people who want to give tax effectively to various churches, charities or people in Christian service find an account with one of these organisations helpful.

The money is given to the organisation and they will claim the tax back. You have a 'charity cheque book' to make payments to the organisations of your choice, or you can set up a Standing Order with the organisation for your regular giving.

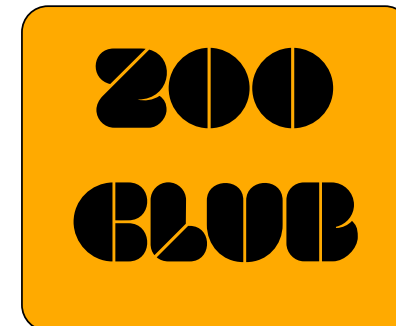
